

Install your Lavish Presets

A step-by-step guide for Lightroom Classic, Lightroom CC, and Lightroom Mobile (iPhone & Android).

What you received

Every Lavish Preset collection includes:

- **.xmp files** — for Lightroom Classic and Lightroom CC on desktop.
- **.dng files** — for Lightroom Mobile on iPhone & Android.
- A quick-start welcome email with your download links.

Tip: unzip the download **before** importing. iOS Files and Android downloads can hide the raw files inside the archive.

Lightroom Classic & Lightroom CC · Desktop (.xmp)

Lightroom Classic

1. Open **Lightroom Classic** and go to the **Develop** module.
2. In the left panel, find **Presets**. Click the **+** icon and choose **Import Presets...**
3. Select every **.xmp** file in the unzipped Lavish folder (Cmd/Ctrl+A) and click **Import**.
4. Your collection appears under **Presets** → **User Presets** → **Lavish**. Click any preset to apply.
5. Fine-tune exposure and white balance for your image — presets are a starting point, not a finish line.

Lightroom CC (Cloud / Desktop)

1. Open **Lightroom CC** and open any photo in the **Edit** panel.
2. Click the **Presets** icon on the right, then the **three-dot menu** → **Import Presets...**
3. Select every **.xmp** file from your Lavish folder and click **Import**.
4. Presets appear under **User Presets** → **Lavish**. They sync to Lightroom Mobile automatically when you sign in with the same Adobe ID.

If Lightroom says “*preset could not be imported*”, the file is still inside the .zip — unzip and try again.

Lightroom Mobile · iPhone & Android (.dng)

The free Lightroom Mobile app is all you need — a paid Adobe subscription is not required to install or use your Lavish Presets on mobile.

Setup

1. Install **Adobe Lightroom** from the App Store or Google Play.
2. Create a free **Adobe ID** and sign in — this syncs your presets across devices.
3. Download the **.dng bundle** to your phone. Unzip it (iOS: tap the .zip in Files → the extracted folder appears next to it).

Import the .dng files

1. Open Lightroom Mobile. Tap the + (Add Photos) icon at the bottom right.
2. Choose **From Files** (iOS) or **Device** (Android) and select every **.dng** file.
3. The .dng files import as photos into an album — that is expected. Each one carries the edit inside it.

Save them as reusable presets

1. Open a .dng photo. Tap the **☰ menu** in the top-right corner.
2. Tap **Create Preset**. Name it (e.g. “Lavish · Signature 01”) and save it to a new group called **Lavish**.
3. Repeat for each .dng. Once saved, the presets live under **Presets → User Presets → Lavish** and apply to any photo with one tap.

Colors look off after applying? The .dng carries the edit, not your camera profile. Set **Profile → Adobe Color** (or your camera's matching profile) and re-apply.

Troubleshooting

Import fails / “Unsupported file format”

The download finished partway. Re-download over Wi-Fi and confirm the file size matches your email receipt.

.dng file imports but no preset appears

That is normal — .dng files import as photos. Open one, tap **☰ → Create Preset** to save it.

Presets don't sync across devices

Sign in to the same free Adobe ID on every device and give it a minute. Sync is Adobe-side, not ours.

Preset makes skin look orange or green

White balance was captured differently on your camera. Adjust **Temp** and **Tint** sliders after applying the preset.
